Hello Highlands Ranch Soccer Association Friends,

Thank you for your patience during this unprecedented time. All of us at Highlands Ranch Soccer Association are concerned for your well-being and wish you and your family perfect health throughout this pandemic. By now you have received communication from Colorado Soccer Association with details about the continued suspension of the Spring 2020 season. We understand fully the impact of not being able to conduct the spring soccer season and this has been extremely difficult for all of us. We live for seeing your children on the fields and being there to share in their joy. Our club has been closely monitoring the developments of the COVID-19 pandemic and our priority remains focused on the safety and welfare of everyone in our community.

We are working closely with Colorado Soccer Association (CSA) to play this spring. **In a recommendation from Colorado Soccer Association Advisory Committee and approved by the Colorado Soccer Association Board of Directors, that soccer play in Colorado continues to be suspended with the earliest “Return to Play” date now set for April 18th.** A further evaluation of the feasibility of the new ‘return to play’ date will happen April 3rd or no later than two weeks prior to the return of play date. Should the return to play date need to be extended again, the CSA Advisory Committee will meet and propose a new date to return for approval by the CSA Board of Directors.

We are prepared to start the season as soon as we receive approval from our federal, state, local authorities and CSA. We are working on many scenarios with different start dates and working with our field providers to extend the season so the kids are able to play.

As we settle in for several weeks away from the field we are coming up with creative ways to keep your players engaged, interacting and competing. We are working everyday to come up with ideas on how to deliver our product to you. We have begun by posting videos every day with skills to work on at home and how to use the different spaces you may have.
